Footnotes

PRINCESS BUTON lagged behind in the two and three paths around the first turn, commenced a rally four wide into the far turn, angled into the two path midway around that bend, closed strongly, split horses nearing the sixteenth pole and readily drew clear under a drive. FAST AND FRIENDLY stalked the pace three wide through the opening half, bid in the three path around the far turn, took the lead nearing the lane, vied outside of THAT'S IT FOR ME through upper stretch, could not match strides with the winner in midstretch but finished willingly to be clearly second best. THAT'S IT FOR ME rushed up four wide into the first turn to press the pace, took the lead late on that turn, drew clear nearing the far turn, was confronted by FAST AND FRIENDLY near the three-sixteenths pole, vied inside of that rival to upper stretch then tired and just lasted for the show. SPACE ODYSSEY settled off the pace along the rail in the clear around the first turn, swung four wide to advance leaving the quarter pole, angled back in in upper stretch and finished evenly. PRINCESS MACHO saved ground and never factored. DISTINCT TREASURE stalked the pace inside around the first turn and faded. BOSSY BOP set the pace along the rail, was collared near the nine-sixteenths marker, prompted the pace inside past the three eighths pole then faltered. LITTLE PRIZED was unhurried in the two path early, rallied three and four wide around the far turn, bolted and lost her rider nearing the lane. The Stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident nearing the lane and found no reason to alter the original order of finish.
