RITEPLACE RITETIME prompted the pace three and four wide then in a strong drive was up in the final strides. THE URUGAUCHA pressed the issue from the inside, was on even terms near the sixteenth pole but came up short in a strong effort. ATLANTIC BEACH set the pace on the rail, dug in through the stretch, missed in a good effort. SUPER SILVER forced the issue three and four wide, finished strongly. DANCING TURK moved up just off the rail, closed with a rush through the lane. RACINGMOLLYGREEN exchanged bumps with FANCY CITIDIAMOND at the start, was kept four wide and finished with good energy. VIRGINIA HARBOUR bumped shortly after the start, never threatened three wide. WILD CHIC was no factor on the rail. FANCY CITIDIAMOND exchanged bumps with RACINGMOLLYGREEN at the start, failed to menace three wide.
