ICE BERLIN forced the issue from the inside, bid five wide on the turn, gained the lead in deep stretch and lasted. FORT SEATTLE advanced along the inside, angled out for the drive and closed with a rush. MONEY TO BURN saved ground, rallied four wide on the turn, finished well. GUSKA'S GOLD prompted the pace three wide, made a clear lead on the turn, led until late stretch. MISTER FIPS (IRE) stalked the leaders three wide, finished willingly. SMOKIN THINGS off the pace three wide, finished with good energy. LAGO bumped at the start, failed to menace four wide. KING LEOPOLD set the pace on the rail, was still a factor on the turn, gave way in the drive. J'BOY sluggish at the start, made little impact four wide. ME TARZAN broke in a tangle to the outside, bumped with LAGO then trailed along the inside.
