SILENT SHOT alternated for the lead with LIVELY REPARATIONS, fell back some around the turn, came again through the stretch to be up in the final strides. LIVELY REPARATIONS just off the rail with the pace, gained a clear lead down the backstretch, remained clear on the turn then in a long drive was out finished. HI HO BAMBINO kept four wide moving up along the backstretch, moved to contention on the turn but came up empty when asked in the drive. PAGAN CAT always within striking distance three wide, lacked a closing bid in the lane. WYATT'S HOPE with the leaders four wide, lacked the needed late rally. HE'S A PRIZE was no factor, four and five wide. RUTLEDGE STAR prompted the pace from the rail, tired. DOC THUNDERBOLT well placed along the inside for six furlongs, had little left for the drive.
