SEA DUBAI set the pace inside, opened up around the turn, was ridden out through the stretch. BETTIN ON M J went to his knees at start, was taken sharply outside down the backstretch, launched a four wide bid around turn, closed strongly. HESOGOODWITHMONEY prompted the issue four wide, finished willingly. HENRY THE LOVER ducked in, bumping INFIELD just after start, pressed the pace three wide, was outfinished. LORD OF DANCE stalked the leaders while racing three wide around the turn, lacked a late response. INFIELD bumped just after the start, raced four wide around the turn, was no threat. BROADBROOK pressed the pace between horses, weakened. The rider of INFIELD lodged an objection, claiming interference by HENRY THE LOVER at the start. After a review of the video tape replays, the Stewards disqualified HENRY THE LOVER from fourth and placed him sixth.
