Footnotes

DI COLAS GIRL dropped back from the early lead to stalk the pace off the rail, moved to the front approaching the five sixteenths pole, drew clear toward the quarter, was urged away through the final turn, widened under a drive then allowed to relax in late yards. CUT IT UP, well back inside, angled out with a bid past the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn extremely wide and finished evenly to be second best. DID YOU KNOW rated off the early pace inside, gave chase from the half mile pole then leveled off down the lane. LIONONEOONE drew clear toward the first turn, set the pace to the three eighths pole, gave chase nearing the five sixteenths pole but flattened stride through the final turn. HOLIDAY DREAMING settled just off the early pace about the three path, took aim into the backstretch, gave close chase to the quarter pole but leveled off while losing ground on the final turn. RITEPLACE RITETIME came away awkward and in, kept just off the early pace four wide, had aim leaving the first turn and continued in close chase to the quarter pole before leveling off. LIMIT LASS, squeezed at the start, ran five wide the opening turn and never factored. VIRGINIA PARK's rider lost his irons when shut off at the break then raced wide and was not encouraged.
