Footnotes

NO BODY'S SON lacked speed, raced wide around the far turn, closed determinedly, bumped with BIG STONEY near the wire and was up in time. BIG STONEY stalked the pace two wide, took the lead entering the far turn, opened up turning for home, bumped with the winner in deep stretch and just missed. RUGBYS HILL lacked speed, moved up three wide around the far turn and weakened in the drive. POLISH LOGIC advanced leaving the backstretch, worked between horses on the far turn and weakened in the stretch. JUDGE MARSHALL , well off the rail, was not a late factor. MAKE A WESH , wide turning for home, was not a factor. LOGANS LIL DEVIL saved ground on the first turn and gave way. BEEPIN ANNA BOPPIN set the pace along the rail and faltered. An objection by the rider of BIG STONEY against the winner for alleged interference near the wire was not allowed.
