Footnotes

TIGRESS SEVEN settled back from the early pace outside, bid leaving the half mile pole, rounded the final turn five wide, dueled to the lead in late yards and dug in from the sixteenth pole to turn back the challenge of the runner-up. GIN SWEEP, well back off the rail, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, eased five wide through the final turn, angled to the outside at the eighth pole, flanked the winner from the sixteenth though couldn't get by. SILK OF SARI rated off the pace inside, rallied to the front at the quarter pole, contested a slim advantage through the final turn, gave up the lead entering the stretch, dug in to regain brief slim control a sixteenth away but outfinished the closing yards. OMARA DEVIL settled back about the three path, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, steadied from a closing gap at the head of the lane, came between those horses with a bid leaving the eighth pole then lacked room late. ALWAYSACONTEST rated a slim lead inside, was caught at the quarter pole, continued in close chase through the final turn, recovered the advantage at the head of the lane and held on to midstretch before giving way. GRAEMY, off the early pace about the four path, gave chase from the half mile pole, drew close approaching the final turn then leveled off in the lane. WILDCAT SKIER rated back from the early pace inside, gave chase through the backstretch, lacked room at the head of the lane and weakened from there. FLATTERING ANNIE rated with the pace two deep, gave chase from the five sixteenths pole but gave way on the final turn.
