GONE PROSPECTING advanced three and four wide then under a strong drive was up in the final strides. ZAVALLA DANDY moved up three and four wide, closed with a rush through the lane. CLASSICPERFORMANCE pressed the pace from the rail, gained a slim lead down the backstretch, missed in a strong effort. AINTHATRIGHONEY trailed for a half, rallied three wide around the turn, finished well. GREAT COMMANDER rushed up three wide along the backstretch, loomed boldly on the turn, weakened in the drive. LOWES ISLAND five wide down the backstretch, angled to the inside on the turn, lacked a closing bid. CASH BROKER was used up after a half along the inside. GOOD TO BE TOUGH set the early pace, stopped after a half.
