Footnotes

ALBRECHT gained a slim lead down the backstretch, drew on even terms around the turn and into the stretch then was all out to prevail. TOREADOR got to the inside moving up, made a slim lead down the backstretch then in a long drive, came up short in a game effort. BAMFER with the leaders three wide, lacked a late response. ROCK OUT five wide around the first two turns, was four wide along the backstretch, lacked the needed rally. DERWINS PROSPECTOR within striking distance four and five wide, eased down three wide on the last turn and had no late bid. DYLAN RAY six wide around the first turn, angled to the rail on the second turn, had little left after three quarters. PENNPIKE was used up after a half, three wide. JETSPREE set the early pace on the rail, stopped after six furlongs and was easing through the stretch.
