Footnotes

TWICE WILD moved to the front for inside position, rated the pace off the rail, was pressured toward the quarter pole, driven into the lane and dug in under determined handling to best the runner-up. WILD PROOF came inward leaving the gate getting his heels clipped, rated close inside, was reluctant to occupy the tight opening at the rail through the final turn, bid inside the winner at the head of the lane and dueled gamely close while grudgingly ceding in later yards. SHAMSS settled close to the pace about the four path, gave chase from the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn four wide and finished evenly for show. DECOLATOR rated close off the rail, was hemmed in past the five sixteenths pole, boxed at the winner's heels leaving the final turn then leveled off down the lane. CANAVERAL DANCER, a step slow to break, clipped the heels of Wild Proof a stride later, settled back off the rail early, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole then leveled off in the stretch. TAXICAB bobbled slightly a few strides from the gate, moved toward the outside leaving the first turn, gave chase from the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn five wide and weakened in the stretch. LION'S REIGN drew aim leaving the nine sixteenths pole, gave chase from the three eighths, remained a close factor rounding the final turn but lacked further response in the stretch. The stewards reviewed and dismissed a claim of foul against the rider of the runner-up, lodged by the rider of Canaveral Dancer, for interference leaving the gate.
