Footnotes

REGAL COMPANY rated with the early pace two deep, took over past the half mile pole, was pressured from the three eighths, urged away through the final turn then kept alert down the lane. ROCK THE RED, off the pace inside, started a bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, eased outward on the final turn, entered the stretch in the four path and finished best for place. EXPLOSIVE WHIRL dropped well back from the early pace racing well off the rail, bid saving ground nearing the five sixteenths pole, angled five wide leaving the final turn and finished evenly in third. GRAN NEGRO hopped leaving the gate and never factored. UARESOGOOD showed the way inside the opening turn, gave chase past the half mile pole, steadied nearing the final turn then faded through the turn. HUNTER'S HOLLOW, just off the early pace off the rail, gave chase nearing the three eighths pole then leveled off rounding the final turn. LONG SHADOW, awkward at the break, chased the leaders outside leaving the first turn but faded through the backstretch.
