Footnotes

WAR LION bobbled a stride out, steadily made up ground inside through the backstretch, eased three wide rounding the turn and reached the front in late yards. NUCKY THOMPSON was hustled with a slim brief early lead off the rail, engaged in a duel past the seven sixteenths pole to recover control a furlong later, inched clear on the turn, dug in from the head of the lane but was caught in late yards. HONG KONG HARRY chased the early pace from the outside, saved ground approaching the turn and finished well to gain show. SOLVE THE CODE gave distant chase inside, lacked room leaving the turn but finished well. AARON'S LEGEND was hustled to a slim lead two deep inside the seven sixteenths pole, briefly set a pressured pace from there, gave back the lead to Nucky Thompson past the five sixteenths pole, continued a close factor through the turn but lacked further response in the stretch. PEAK TOP chased the pace about the three path, saved ground on the turn then leveled off in the stretch. CABO BORRACHO, briefly close in mid track, chased the pace through the backstretch but leveled off five wide on the turn. THUNDERELLO DANCER was not a factor. OPEN CAREFULLY chased the early pace outside but proved empty six wide on the turn. CRAZY AS CAN BE gave close early chase three wide then faded while losing ground on the turn.
