SLATON prompted the pace from the inside, launched a five wide bid down the backstretch, dueled for the lead around the far turn, emerged with a narrow advantage at the top of the lane and finished gamely to prevail. SECOND TO NONE pressed three and four wide, took a narrow advantage around the far turn, finished well to just miss. BYJAX advanced four wide around the far turn, closed with a rush. BE MINE VALENTINE moved up three wide around the far turn, finished strongly. CALAWAY advanced inside, came four wide around the far turn, finished willingly while drifting in at the top of the lane. DR. FINNEGAN forced the issue inside, was done after half. RACKLEY stalked the leaders four wide but lacked a late response. SANDRO PAZZO set the pace, gave way around the turn then was easing through stretch.
