PRIZE OF PROSPECT stalked the pace inside around the first turn, eased into the four path turning into the backstretch, advanced from the three-eighths pole, reached even terms nearing the three-sixteenths marker, drifted five wide into the lane, dueled between rivals through the stretch and prevailed in a game effort. PRINCESS PUFF lacked speed in the two path, circled four wide around the far turn, was floated six wide into the lane when the winner drifted out, bid outside and hung while continuing on her left lead. MOLLIE LIL GIRL set the pace along the rail, dueled inside of the winner around the far turn and through midstretch and gave way grudgingly. FINE CASHMERE prompted the pace three wide around the first turn, vied outside of MOLLIE LIL GIRL down the backstretch, dueled two wide between rivals around the far turn, dropped back slightly nearing the lane, was in tight in upper stretch and weakened. MEAN GREEN MACHINE settled off the pace in the three path, swung six wide leaving the three-sixteenths marker and drifted in and out in the stretch. MOMMASLILGIRLYGIRL broke in a tangle, raced four wide around the first turn, saved some ground around the far turn and never threatened. BONNYGREEN pressed the pace two wide between rivals around the first turn, steadied nearing the half-mile pole, faltered and was easing through the lane.
