WILD TEPU set the pace three wide, slowly drew clear through the stretch. CARINA BAY crowded at the start, moved up four and five wide and finished strongly. WOMPUM RIDGE prompted the issue from the rail, lacked a closing bid. CARSON CITY DUDE bore out very wide at the start and steadied, was six and seven wide and closed with a rush through the lane. STORM SHUTTLE bore out at the start, pressed the pace three and four wide, lacked a late response. SONG OF ARABIA stalked the leaders from the inside, lacked late bid. PEE WEE'S PEAK off a step slow then in tight at the start, found his best stride late while four wide. CASPIAN BEACH bumped and squeezed back at the start, failed to menace three and four wide. T'S LUCKY forced out then bumped with CASPIAN BEACH at the start, was no factor three wide. WILD JERSEY BOY flashed early speed five wide, steadily fell back.
