SAY WHAT YOU WANT settled off the pace inside, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, eased four wide through the final turn, was carried outward in the upper stretch but dug in to take over in late yards. ACALLFORJOE, four wide into the first turn, settled close leaving the half mile pole, rallied from the three eighths to take over toward the quarter pole, raced clear on the final turn but was caught in late yards. SNABB FLICA stalked the pace off the rail, bid at the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn three wide, veered outward under a left hand drive in the upper stretch then had no further response when straightened away. I DON'T TELL, well back about the four path, bid from the quarter pole, saved some ground on the final turn then finished evenly near the rail. WHEREAS THE BEDROOM moved to the front three wide nearing the nine sixteenths pole, saved ground while drawing clear toward the three eighths, was pressured approaching the turn while giving up the lead but gave chase to the lane before weakening. DI COLAS TEAM raced well back saving ground. AFLEET CHILL kept close to the pace to the quarter pole before fading.
