AL N CON set the pace along the rail, drew clear around the far turn and held clear while drifting out a bit under right-handed urging. PARK RULES chased the winner two wide and had a mild stretch gain. CAPE SABLE was bumped just after the start, raced along the rail and rallied for the show. MASTIC VILLAGE lacked speed, advanced four wide around the turn, came six wide into the lane and rallied belatedly. LADY BOBCAT CHAMPS failed to menace while racing five wide. HITCHIN' TOTHEMOON bumped with CAPE SABLE just after the start, saved ground and never threatened. GOLDEN HALL was outrun while racing five wide. NO ATTRACTION chased the pace three wide and tired nearing the lane. UNLIKELY HERO had brief four wide speed.
