CLASSY CITIZEN stalked the pace three wide, challenged leaving the seven sixteenths pole, took over midway on the final turn, drew clear past the three sixteenths pole, drifted slightly on entering the stretch but dug in under steady encouragement to just last. THUNDER CLAN rated close in the three and four paths, bid saving ground leaving the three eighths pole, was gaining slowly through the lane and just missed. BREEZY ARCH, well off the early pace off the rail, started a bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, saved ground on the final turn, eased to the four path into the lane and finished evenly in show. HATTUSA rated off the early pace toward the outside, bid leaving the half mile pole then leveled off in the five path of the final turn. MY DAUGHTERS' KIDS showed the way off the rail, came under pressure from the seven sixteenths pole, was caught midway on the final turn then weakened in the lane. IM NOT MAD IM EVEN eased out rounding the first turn, entered the backstretch widest then never factored. QUALITY SHOW, reluctant to load, saved ground well off the early pace, moved toward mid track leaving the first turn then showed no response through the backstretch.
