CINNAMON STRITZEL prompted the issue just off the rail, gained the lead on the turn, held clear under a drive. FOOL PROOF advanced three wide, finished well. POW WOW POWER within striking distance three wide, finished strongly. LIVELY REPARATIONS set the pace under heavy pressure, gave way around the turn. GREEN KEY moved up four and five wide, made a mild gain through the stretch. RICHWOOD HALL flashed brief foot along the inside. FORBES never was a factor, five wide. MC TAGGART flashed early speed three wide, had little left after a half. P. T. DANCER a pace factor inside, lacked the needed rally. BEA'S WEST WING stopped after a half on the rail.
