Footnotes

FARNELL'S ALLEY was hustled along outside to position herself on the lead two deep at the five sixteenths pole, lost a path entering the stretch but dug in under determined handling to inch clear toward the wire. SHENANDOAH GIRL was hustled along inside with a brief early lead and stayed gamely on while grudgingly ceding the stretch. MY SOPHIA FIELDS chased the pace about the four path on the backstretch, took aim four wide at the top of the stretch and finished evenly outside. WATCH AND WONDER chased the pace about the three path, saved some ground on the turn then leveled off near the rail. PRINCESS HARRIETT gave distant chase through the backstretch, angled five wide rounding the turn but had nothing further in the lane. I M UNBOOBOOABLE gave chase from the outside though never factored. WILD CHLOE WON chased the pace from the three path, saved ground on the turn and had nothing left in the lane. PRAISE DIXIE, briefly close while giving chase off the rail, faded past the three eighths pole. The stewards reviewed a claim of foul against the winning rider, lodged by the rider of the runner-up, but found insufficient evidence of an infraction.
