Footnotes

WILLIAM'S PRAYER settled off the pace about the four path, edged closer after the opening half mile, had aim three wide at the three eighths pole, dueled to the lead at the quarter, raced clear on the final turn and held well with steady handling. BEAU AMERICAN, well back toward mid track, started his advance from the half mile pole, bid leaving the first sixteenths, rounded the final turn about the three path and finished evenly to be second best. FORBES rated back inside, bid off the rail toward the three eighths pole, improved his position on the final turn and finished evenly. SOUTHERN FOLLY opened up a long early lead inside, rated to the half mile pole, came under pressure at that point, held a slim lead most of the backstretch, yielded control toward the final turn then faded through the turn. GHOSTLY THUNDER, well back off the rail, bid leaving the three eighths pole, eased outward on the final turn, entered the stretch five wide and finished evenly to pass tiring rivals. D K'S WILDCAT rated off the pace off the rail, edged closer through the second turn, dueled between horses to take a slim but brief lead at the five sixteenths pole, gave up control at the quarter pole then gave way in the stretch. PALO DURO CANYON kept close to the pace the opening half mile then faded through the backstretch. JULES CAESAR, three wide the second turn, kept off the pace toward mid track, bid from the three eighths pole but weakened on the final turn. CUT THE CORNER steadied at the rail through the opening turn then dropped well back inside.
