Footnotes

RITZA pressed the pace three wide, gained a clear lead on the turn, lugged out into stretch, was straightened in the upper stretch then drew off and won driving. PLAID PATCHES set the pace along the rail, could not match strides with the winner and was second best in the drive. SKY DANCERS GEM rallied five wide around the turn to loom a strong factor but failed to sustain her bid in the lane. DIXIE IN RAGTIME saved ground, had no rally. LAPHERSLASTLAUGH stalked the pace four wide, failed to respond. PROSPECTIVE DANCER prompted the pace three wide, lacked a late response. BLUE FROSTY MUG well placed along the rail for a half, faded. GUSSIE UP flashed early speed three wide, tired.
