WILD WEST BELLE settled in to force three issue three wide, was set down for the drive, gained the lead in deep stretch. SUMMER WIND BLUES pressed the pace while three wide, remained a strong factor on the turn and finished willingly. TUFTIKUS advanced four and five wide, began her rallied around the turn then closed with a rush through the lane. SPIN MOVE set the pace from the inside, held clear on the turn, weakened the last sixteenth. EDY M saved ground, eased out three wide on the turn then finished well through the stretch. ROYAL PROBE prompted the issue from the rail, lacked a late response. AMERICAN GEM made little impact, three wide. LADY DI flashed early speed along the inside but had little left for the drive. YO PLAY off a step slow, never was a factor four wide. LITTLE BAD JEANNIE stumbled just after the start then showed little.
