Footnotes

DAWN'S DAY forced the issue from the rail, bid four wide on the turn, gained the lead near the sixteenth pole then was all out to prevail. NICOLE'S PROSPECT gained a slim lead down the backstretch, held a clear lead on the turn, led until near the sixteenth pole and was clearly second best. SIR PITT dueled on a slim lead, dug in down the backstretch, gave way in the drive. PAT'S CAT MAN off the pace three wide, rallied around the turn but failed to sustain his bid. SMART PACE bore out and steadied at the start, was with the pace three wide, lacked a late response. BLUFF THE WEATHER off a step slow, loomed boldly four wide on the turn, came up empty in the drive. WESH'S TEXAS STAR well placed along the inside, had no rally when asked. UP TO MISCHIEF three wide down the backstretch, was five wide on the turn, never threatened in the drive. BEEPIN ANNA BOPPIN flashed early speed three wide, steadily fell back. LIL MARVIN rank at the start, broke down on the backstretch.
