Footnotes

FEISTY DREAMER prompted the pace two wide around the first turn, sprinted clear on the backstretch, hugged the rail on the far turn and was under brisk urging in the drive. FRIENDLY AMERICAN , three wide entering the stretch, had a slight rally. PIZZA LADY in the four path leaving the far turn, bumped with LINDA'S CANDY near the eighth pole and rallied mildly between horses. LINDA'S CANDY , five wide turning for home, finished willingly after bumping near the eighth pole with PIZZA LADY. TALLY'S SONG , two wide entering the stretch, angled to the rail in upper stretch and failed to be a factor. I'VEGOTAMAGICSPOT , three wide the first turn, chased the pace two wide on the far turn and gave way in the drive. RESTINGNSLIGOCREEK , three wide both turns, was not a factor. LIL T N T had speed along the rail and faltered after a half mile. CROSS TALK saved ground, chased the early pace then faltered leaving the backstretch. There was a stewards' inquiry concerning the run into the stretch but no action was taken.
