MEMPHIS SUNRISE stalked the pace inside, bid two wide between rivals near the three-eighths pole, took the lead nearing the far turn, dueled inside of PREPPIES LIL MAN around that bend then drew off under a drive in the lane. PREPPIES LIL MAN stalked the pace three wide, bid nearing the far turn, dueled outside of the winner around that bend, weakened in upper stretch, drifted in leaving the sixteenth pole and held well clear for the place. JENNY'S EARTHQUAKE chased the pace while racing seven wide around the first turn, went five wide around the far turn and was no threat to the top two. SERVICE OR ELSE failed to menace while racing inside. TEETEE TUCKER saved ground to no avail. PRIVATE UNION set the pace in the two path and tired around the far turn. EXHORTER was outrun while racing three and four wide. DEUTERIUM trailed in the three path.
