Footnotes

TOBE SUAVE moved up just off the rail, was set down for the drive and up in the final strides. GUSKA'S GOLD set the pace under pressure, moved clear on the turn, led until the final strides. FORT SEATTLE three and four wide, finished strongly. RICH DISCOVERY advanced five wide, rallied around the turn, finished willingly. LEVITE six wide along the backstretch, loomed three wide on the turn, came up empty in the drive. MR. ZULU tardy then bumped at the start, was within striking distance along the inside, had no late bid. SMOKIN THINGS bore out and bumped with MR. ZULU at the start, was with the leaders three wide, failed to respond when asked in the lane. STEVEBISCUIT forced the issue three and four wide, lacked the needed rally. AMERICAN STEEL pressed the pace from rail, tired. EZ MAC bore out and steadied at the start, was five wide for a half, had little left for the drive.
