Footnotes

BLACKBERRY WINTER set the pace along the rail, turned back a challenger on the far turn then pulled away while kept to his business. PREMIER'S WHINNY raced along the rail, was steadied in close quarters near the three and a half furlongs pole, swung to the three path inside the quarter pole, chased the winner in a willing effort while second best. SUPER BRIAN lacked speed, hugged the rail around the far turn and through the stretch and rallied mildly. TURF KING, fractious in the starting gate, circled the first turn, advanced to reach contention on the backstretch, raced two wide on the far turn and tired in the drive. CIVIL HAT, no factor, raced in the two path between horses entering the stretch. HOTEL SIERRA advanced three wide leaving the backstretch and weakened through the stretch. LOGGER MIKE was outrun. NIFTY ROCKY chased the pace, raced in the two path on the far turn and gave way. RED BEAU LEO, outrun, dropped back
