GET A WIGGLE ON surged clear to set the pace inside, came under a drive leaving the turn and held well with steady encouragement. SHES A SILVERTRAIN gave chase about the four path and dueled for place. SWEET SOPHIE gave chase off the rail, was jostled near the five sixteenths pole, angled in mid turn then outfinished for place. EVEN ME chased the early pace widest, saved some ground through the turn, eased five wide into the lane and leveled off. STACK GAL, shuffled back near the rail at the three eighths pole, was brushed at the five sixteenths pole then steadied from tight quarters mid turn. MISS FRANCHESCA gave chase toward the outside though never factored. CAJUN BORN lacked room most of the backstretch. SOTTERLEY, brushed near the five sixteenths pole, was not a factor. MISS BRANCH WOOD chased the early pace off the rail then checked when shut off mid turn.
