Footnotes

SAINT CHOCOLATE moved up four wide down the backstretch to become a strong factor, gained the lead three wide around the turn, drew off through the stretch under a steady drive. ACADEMY KING forced the issue three and four wide but was second best. POPPA K prompted the pace just off the rail, lacked a late response. DYLAN MY VILLAIN up close early, settled off the pace three wide along the backstretch, lacked a late bid when asked in the stretch. MALIBU MOON COMA set the pace on a clear lead for a half, dug in around the turn, gave way in the drive. MOJAVE'S GOLD found his best stride late, three wide. RIFLE RANGE was no factor, three wide. WITHALLDUERESPECT flashed brief foot on the rail.
