Footnotes

RED LIGHT set the pace on the rail, drew off around the turn then was all out to last. LUXURY TAX advanced three and four wide, closed with a rush through the lane. PATCHAROANY tardy at the start, moved up three wide, altered out five wide in mid stretch and finished well. MADDIE'S MAIN MAN pressed the issue from the inside, lacked a closing bid. REGAL COMPANY in tight after the start, was a pace factor three and four wide, lacked a late response. DANGLINGONTHEEDGE angled down sharply at the start, forced the pace along the rail, lacked a late bid. GANGA made little impact from the inside. SADDLER'S BOY stumbled after the start then was crowded, never threatened on the rail. SOUND AFFAIR checked hard shortly after the start on the rail and fell back. BEE REGAL sluggish at the start, was five wide along the backstretch, eased down three wide on the turn while no factor.
