Footnotes

AM SO HAPPY, bumped off stride at the break, rated off the pace off the rail on the backstretch, bid nearing the five sixteenths pole, took over nearing the head of the lane, dug in to inch clear midstretch and kept to steady encouragement to maintain that advantage. SONNY C broke in making contact with Twelve Degrees, gave close chase after a brief outside lead in mid track and dug in leaving the turn but outflanked the length of the stretch. DIXIE WHISKEY gave distant chase off the rail, eased outward through the turn, bore out to the nine or ten path entering the stretch and finished well to get show in the final yards. SOLVE THE CODE gave distant chase toward mid track, saved some ground to improve through the turn then leveled off in late stretch. UNBRIDLED BATTLE chased the early pace from the inside, eased toward mid track at the top of the stretch and finished evenly. TWELVE DEGREES was bumped in and into Am So Happy leaving the gate, chased the pace toward the outside, was carried to the ten or eleven path leaving the turn and leveled off from there. SPORTS BAR chased the pace inside, was checked from tight quarters at the rail nearing the head of the lane and weakened from there. BAI THE CAT chased the pace from the outside then leveled off while six wide on the turn. CRAZY AS CAN BE accelerated to a slim lead about the three path, inched clear past the quarter pole but weakened from the top of the stretch. THE THINGS YOU DID was hustled along about the four path to press the early pace, dropped back three wide through the turn, showed no further response into the lane and broke down approaching the wire.
