TIPTOP SLEW stalked the pace five wide, gained the lead in mid stretch then was all out to last. AYE A TREAT split foes on the backstretch, came four wide on the turn, closed with a rush and just missed. ASHBY INN saved ground, angled out five wide around the turn then finished strongly in the drive. KEYSTONE COMET inside, closed willingly. OUT IN THE COLD well placed, gained the lead in the upper stretch but weakened late. SIOUXPERHONEY four wide backstretch, tired after a half. LIGHTENING LASSIE set the pace inside, had little left for the drive. MEADOWVILLE was outrun. O'LARCAIN hard used, tired.
