Footnotes

ALMOST DAD saved ground early to rate the pace two deep, was pressured near the rail leaving the five sixteenths pole and dug in under steady handling to widen. MARY'S PRIZE stumbled making contact with Miners Blues leaving the gate, moved with the winner to the head of the pack to stalk that one inside, gave chase leaving the five sixteenths pole and finished evenly to be second best. SPACE ODYSSEY settled back off the rail, bid toward the quarter pole, rounded the final turn three wide then leveled off in the stretch. MINERS BLUES, bumped at the start, raced well back from the early pace inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, ran toward the rail through the final turn, eased four wide into the stretch but had little left. ELEGANT DIAMOND rated close to the early pace off the rail but lacked sufficient response from the three eighths pole. COPYCAT DIAMOND, well back inside, made a mild bid leaving the five sixteenths pole. GOBLINS TWO STEP was well back and not a factor. ETHLENES MERLOT rounded the first turn in the four path and was through after a half mile.
