Footnotes

SILENT SHOT settled back inside, bid at the three eighths pole, eased four wide toward the quarter pole, steadily improved his position through the turn, dueled to the front past the eighth pole, was driven clear but taken in hand late. THE PACK IS BACK settled off the pace off the rail, rallied to the front three wide at the five sixteenths pole, turned back rivals through the final turn but was caught inside the eighth pole and finished evenly. NEVER MINED settled back toward mid track, bid toward the five sixteenths pole, took aim on the final turn but leveled off in the stretch. KINSTAR settled back about the four path, bid from the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn three wide and ran evenly through the lane. DANCING VALIANT rated with the early pace two deep, moved to the lead toward the half mile pole, was pressured through the backstretch, caught approaching the five sixteenths pole then weakened at the rail on the final turn. TEA TOTTT rated a slim lead inside leaving the first turn, yielded control toward the half mile pole, pressured the leader through the backstretch then faded on the final turn. STEAMROLLER BLUES was not a factor.
