Footnotes

BAKU rated a short lead inside, was hand urged past the three eighths pole, steadily pressured from the quarter and held on under a flattening stride and a hardy stretch drive. BULLET CATCHER rated off the pace toward mid track, bid nearing the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn five wide and gained mildly through the lane though ran out of ground. HEY DOC HOLIDAY stumbled badly leaving the gate, dropped well back outside, started a bid nearing the three sixteenths pole, entered the stretch eight wide then leveled off widest after acquiring third. SOUTHERN FOLLY, in tight early, came out to exchange sharp contact with Mickee's Saga past the three quarter pole, settled close in mid track, bid nearing the quarter pole, rounded the final turn four wide then leveled off down the lane. TITAN LAUNCH rated close off the rail, started a bid leaving the three eighths pole then leveled off rounding the final turn. JUST ASK DADDY saved ground off the early pace, moved out through the opening turn, raced toward mid track from the half mile pole, entered the stretch seven wide and had little left. MICKEE'S SAGA angled in to exchange sharp contact with Southern Folly past the three quarter pole, kept close to the early pace about the three path, gave chase from the three eighths then faded through the lane. OYKEL BRIDGE was through after a half mile. BEAT THE SPREAD raced well back outside.
