**Footnotes**

LITTLE BIT BRATTY, unhurried inside, bid approaching the three eighths pole, took over at the rail leaving the final turn, dueled clear then held on well. SNABB FLICA rated the pace inside, was pressured toward the quarter pole, bore out losing the lead leaving the final turn but quickly recovered stride and finished well. G C'S SPITFIRE rated close to the early pace off the rail, saved ground with a bid leaving the three eighths pole, eased out midway on the final turn, was carried to the six path entering the stretch, outfinished in the duel for place and leveled off toward the wire. ZIRCON rated off the pace off the rail, bid five wide leaving the three eighths pole, was carried to the seven path entering the stretch then finished evenly when straightened away. SHY BYE, strung six wide the opening turn, showed no speed well back and outside, saved some ground on the final turn then finished well widest. DEWEY BEACH, four wide the first turn, moved to contention past the seven sixteenths pole and gave close chase to the quarter before fading on the final turn. I DON'T TELL, off the pace and off the rail, had no rally. SEEKING MILLIE rated close to the early pace off the rail, closed to the heels of the runner-up nearing the three eighths pole and was through after a half mile. SMOOTH TALKIN MISS was strung five wide the opening turn, saved ground approaching the final turn though not a factor.
