Footnotes

BIG BAD IKE, well back toward the outside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, circled horses five wide on the final turn, took over into the lane, was soon clear and widened under steady encouragement. CHIGGER ROO rated well back about the four path, bid leaving the three eighths pole, surged clear of the stalled pacesetter past the quarter pole, was caught entering the stretch and just lasted in the duel for place. SINGIN THE BLUES, well back inside, bid at the rail toward the five sixteenths pole, had aim at the top of the stretch and just missed in the duel for place. EL PISTON, unhurried off the rail, bid nearing the five sixteenths pole, rounded the final turn six wide then leveled off down the lane. BLUES IN THE NIGHT, well back off the rail, bid toward the quarter pole, eased outward on the final turn, took aim in the five path entering the stretch but leveled off from there. GANGA saved ground well back, made a mild rail bid on the final turn and finished evenly. MR. ETHAN gave distant chase off the rail and lacked further response on the final turn. ALLEN'S MONSTER chased the pace from the inside and was through after a half mile. JOYFUL KISS sprinted off to a long early lead to set the pace inside, bolted leaving the first turn, angled back to the inside midway on the backstretch, was caught at the quarter pole, readily faded and came back bleeding from the nose.
