SHAMSS saved ground while racing in mid pack around the first turn, advanced four wide down the backstretch, continued to gain outside around the far turn, took the lead in mid stretch and inched away late. DON'TTRYTHISATHOME prompted the pace inside, ranged up outside to take the lead nearing the quarter pole, dropped in to save ground around the turn, dug in when challenged by the winner in mid stretch and gave way grudgingly. MOJAVE STORM duelled for the lead outside of TUSCAN PRINCE for a half, was no match for the top two. THREE STEPPER stalked the pace inside, lacked a closing bid. TRES DANGEREUX was in tight after the start, unhurried along the rail for a half, advanced inside around the far turn and finished evenly. BREEZY TRIP was never a factor while racing four wide. BEHAVIORAL FINANCE four and five wide, never threatened. AWESOME RULES forced the issue three and four wide, gave way around the far turn. TUSCAN PRINCE set a pressured pace inside for a half, tired going into the far turn.
