Footnotes

SPORTY BOY pressed the issue just off the rail, drew off around the turn, widened through the stretch under urging. BLACKBERRY ROAD moved up five wide down the backstretch, eased down three wide on the turn and was second best. PEACEFUL BLISS set the pace on the rail, gave way around the turn. WARRIORS PRIDE five wide along the backstretch, moved to the inside on the turn then was no match for the winner in the drive. CELTIC RED lugged out into the first turn, bumped with SIR DIAMOND, came four wide around the last turn but never threatened in the drive. STRAIGHT THUNDER bumped sideways into the first turn, forced the pace three wide, had little left for the drive. SIR DIAMOND bumped into the first turn, was five wide down the backstretch, came seven wide on the turn while making little impact. AQUINAS prompted the pace from the rail, tired. BAY BUTTON BILL soundly bumped into the first turn, stopped after a half on the rail. The rider of PEACEFUL BLISS claimed foul against the winner alleging interference near the quarter pole. That claim was disallowed by the Stewards after a review of the video tape replays.
