RIBBON CANE rated well on the lead, drew off around the turn then while shook up once in the upper stretch, was ridden out as much the best. GRACE BAY saved ground, began to rally along the rail down the backstretch, was in sight of the winner into the lane but lugged in late stretch, bumped with LETS JUST DO IT and was no match for the winner. LETS JUST DO IT moved up four wide along the backstretch, was set down on the rail around the turn, was bumped and forced to check in late stretch though no threat to the winner. MARESHA well placed inside, lacked a closing bid. WORLDLY PLEASURE prompted the pace three and four wide then came up empty in the drive. REBEL ROSE within striking distance along the inside, failed to respond when asked in the stretch. POINT LILY bounced around at the start, never threatened three and four wide. REAL WOMEN showed little three wide. SHESANOTHERGRUMP bore out and bumped with POINT LILY at the start then was used up after a half inside. The rider of LETS JUST DO IT claimed foul against GRACE BAY for interference in late stretch. The Stewards agreed after reviewing the video tape replays and disqualified GRACE BAY from second and placed her third.
