LIONONEOONE pressed the pace three wide, made the lead on the turn, was lugging out the last sixteenth while drawing well clear. SHARP BOURBON advanced four wide, finished willingly. ALLEN'S LAST DANCE forced the issue from the rail, lacked a late response. SPINNING LADY lunged at the start, rushed to a slim lead, weakened in the drive. VERO BEACH saved ground, came four wide on the turn, faded through the stretch. SWEET PALMETTO off a step slow then in tight at the start, failed to menace five wide. COULD BE A RUMOR sluggish then bore out at the start, was no factor three and four wide. ELLA BELLA BEAR flashed brief foot, three wide. A DESERT STORY off slow, trailed three wide.
