READY TO CRUISE , ridden down the backstretch, advanced four wide around the turn, challenged for the lead near the eighth pole then drew off under energetic urging. COUNT ON BUDDY disputed the pace three wide, failed to match strides with the winner in the drive but finished gamely to hold the place. ERNEST T BASS saved ground on the turn, eased out inside the eighth pole and closed between horses. FUZZYWUZZYWUZABEAR lacked speed, raced wide leaving the turn and closed late. WANNALOTTALOVIN' dueled two wide between horses and weakened late. WAR LION , squeezed back leaving the starting gate, raced wide on the turn, chased the pace and weakened. TROUBLE MAKIN hugged the rail, disputed the pace to the stretch then weakened. KING JORDAN , no factor, saved ground on the turn. BANDI'S LUV came out leaving the starting gate, raced in the three path on the turn and was not a factor. MARIANOTOJORGE was outrun.
