JOLIE ANGE rushed up to set the pace along the rail, drew clear down the backstretch, widened her advantage around the turn and was ridden out through the lane. COME HERE OONGA prompted the leaders from the rail, could not match strides with the winner around the turn but finished willingly through the lane to be clearly second best. BASK IN THE SUN saved ground in mid pack around the first turn, advanced four wide around the far turn and finished evenly. BELLE OF CAMDEN unhurried inside for a half, swung five wide around the far turn and passed tiring rivals in the stretch. LEVA MAE pressed the pace just outside of the winner, gave way around the far turn. SAINT ZITA was never a factor. LAUSANNE PACT flashed brief speed while racing three wide. FOLLOW THE WHALES forced the issue from the rail, came up empty.
