TUFTIKUS gave distant early chase off the rail, eased six wide through the turn, dueled to the front inside the sixteenth pole and edged clear toward the wire. HALLISTIC exchanged contact with Liononeone shortly after the start, gave chase five wide through the backstretch, had aim in the upper stretch but was outfinished the final sixteenth. QUEEN ROYALE pressured the pace two deep after a brief early lead then leveled off the final sixteenth. LIONONEOONE exchanged contact with Hallistic shortly after the start, pressured the pace three wide, continued a close factor four wide on the turn but proved empty in the stretch. AFLEET CHILL, fractious in the post parade, chased the leaders six and seven wide and finished evenly. DAVINA'S BABY moved to a slim lead inside the three eighths pole and set a pressured pace to the top of the lane before weakening. SUCCULENT SCORE gave close early chase off the rail, was hemmed in through the turn, lacked adequate room inside down the stretch, was in hand the final sixteenth and returned with a bloody left fore. BOBJONCLAIRENALICE raced without hind shoes and trailed.
