**Footnotes**

LOUD RAVENS stalked the early pace off the rail, moved to the lead approaching the three eighths pole, came under pressure nearing the quarter, opened up entering the stretch and widened under steady handling. MILLWOOD came away awkwardly making contact with Blackberry Winter, settled just off the pace off the rail, eased out with a three wide bid approaching the quarter pole, had aim midway on the final turn, was no match for the winner but held on well for place. IN CONFIDENCE, well back about the four path, bid leaving the three eighths pole, saved ground on the final turn, was carried to the five path entering the stretch and finished evenly in show. BLACKBERRY WINTER broke in making contact with Millwood, rated a short lead inside, was caught toward the three eighths pole, gave chase from that point, dropped back through the final turn, lost ground into the lane and had nothing further. SQUISH, well back inside, bid toward the three eighths pole, eased to the three path rounding the final turn and finished evenly to pass tiring rivals. ISLAND LOVE rated back from the early pace toward mid track, bid nearing the three eighths pole, gained mildly approaching the final turn, was carried to the six path entering the stretch and leveled off from there. BAD AS IN GOOD lost ground into the first turn, stalked the early pace about the three path, gave chase toward the five sixteenths pole but faded rounding the final turn. BRADDOCK STREET raced well back toward mid track. INCREDIBLE DREAM saved ground while racing well back. KING JORDAN, awkward at the break, was carried outward into the first turn and through early.
