Footnotes

HEAVENLY APPEAL drafted near the heels of Kelly Irish Girl while inside rounding the first turn, eased off the rail entering the backstretch, bid from the five sixteenths pole to take over nearing the quarter, drew clear midway on the final turn, widened into the lane and wrapped up on from the sixteenth pole. ROCKING LADY settled back inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, eased outward through the final turn, entered the stretch in the three path and proved best for place while not a match for the winner. DISCO DIVA, well back from the early pace inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, improved near the rail to the three sixteenths pole, angled outward leaving the final turn then leveled off after achieving show. BOOK VALUE, well back toward mid track, made a six wide bid approaching the quarter pole and passed tiring horses widest. PHONE JAZZ, off the pace toward mid track, bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, entered the stretch five wide and leveled off from there. SPRINGTIME FROLIC, unprepared for the break, trailed the field to the middle of the final turn and finished evenly with a mild bid from there. KELLY IRISH GIRL rated a short lead inside, was pressured toward the five sixteenths pole, caught at the quarter, gave close chase through the final turn then gave way in the stretch. FIRST COLONY was no factor while saving ground. I'M ALL IRISH stalked the pace about the three path but gave way after a half mile.
