DIXIE DOES IT was hustled to the lead to set a pressured pace off the rail and kept to an all out drive to hold off the steadily gaining runner-up. OY VEY chased the early pace from the outside, rounded the turn five wide, dug in from the head of the lane to reach the outside flank of the winner at the wire and finished well. BLACK BAYOU chased the early pace toward mid track, saved ground through the turn then leveled off down the lane. LADY WITH A FUTURE, pinched back at the break, chased the leaders from mid track, saved some ground on the turn, moved to the six path at the top of the lane and finished well. SHENANDOAH MOON chased the early pace about the three path, was hemmed in nearing the turn, continued her drive past the quarter pole, eased four wide into the lane but leveled off from there. BRYLEIGH GIRL broke out, gave chase down the backstretch, saved ground nearing the turn, eased five wide into the lane and leveled off. GRECIAN LYRIC pressured the winner inside to the quarter pole then faded through the turn. DURING THE CALL saved ground racing well back. MIDSUMMER LADY raced well back. MAGDALENE ROSE gave distant chase toward mid track.
