PINELANDS BARON prompted the pace inside, opened a clear lead around the turn, bore out into the stretch and was all out to last. LIQUID FORCE forced the issue along the rail, rallied three wide on the turn, finished well. CLAUDE MELVIN stalked the leaders four wide, finished strongly. BRUSH WITH VICTORY advanced along the inside, closed with a rush through the lane. ITAKA'S FLIGHT moved up just off the rail, finished willingly. REBEL PRINCE bid four wide around the turn, finished with good energy. PANUCO a pace factor three wide, lacked a late response. SEA DUBAI moved to a long lead along the rail, gave way around the turn. VALLEY TRAIL never was a factor on the rail. SIR FRANCIS PEARL showed early speed, steadily faded.
